8. Malaysia The duty free capital has one of the world's most beautiful resorts, Tanjung Rhu Resort & Spa. See tourism.gov.my

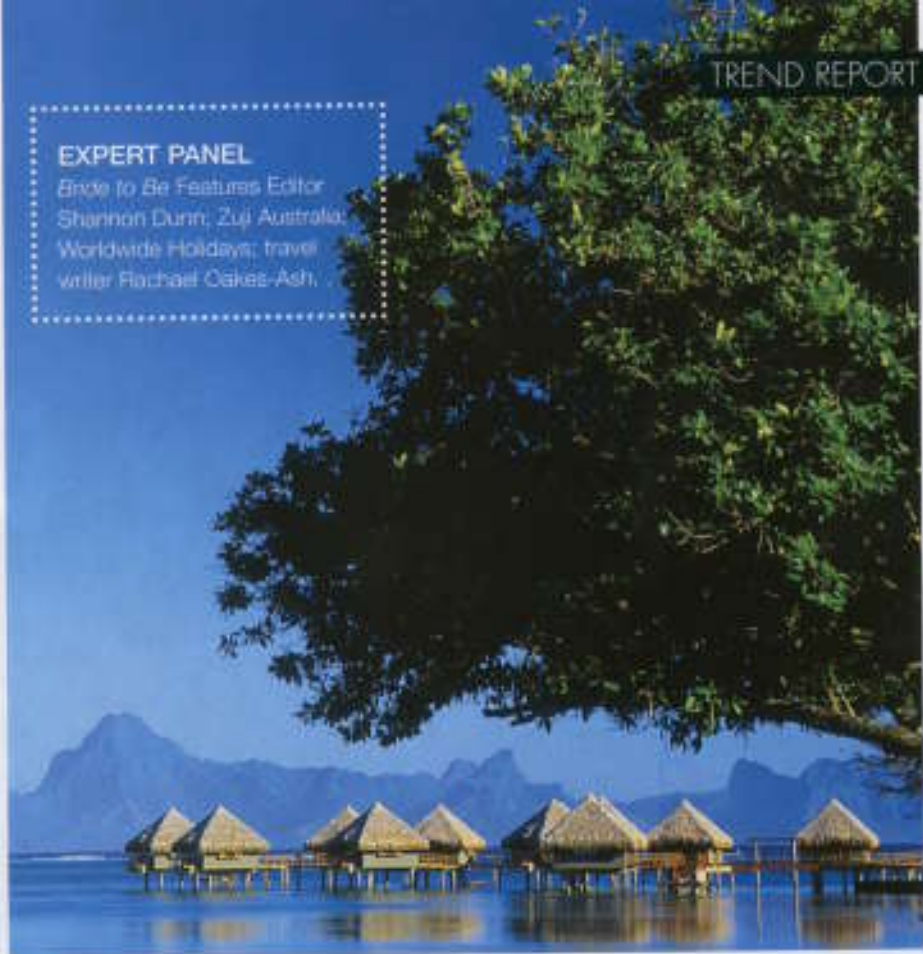
